

<Voting for the award>

- 1. The secretariat will email those who have the right to vote on Wednesday, October 27th, to notify them of the site for voting.
- 2. Award winners will be chosen by open ballot. Please note that you cannot vote for the presenters from the institution to which you belong. If you cast a ballot for anybody from your own institution, your ballot will be recognized as invalid, and will not be counted.
- 3. For the Best Presenter Award, we ask you to select the top three entries each from the young scientist session and the student session. Please evaluate the quality of the candidates' oral presentations and poster discussions in each session. According to the vote counting result, the best one in each category will be chosen as the winner.
- 4. For the Best Discusser Award, we ask you to select the top three entries each from the participants of the young scientist session and the participants of the student session. Please evaluate the quality of the question-and-answer discussion with PI presenters during the PI session. According to the vote counting result, the best one in each category will be chosen as the winner.
