Thank you very much for participating in the 27th East Asia Joint Symposium (the 27th EAJS).

EAJS was started in 1994 with the aim of academic exchange and strengthening the network of researchers in the field of life sciences in East Asia. - 2. Symposium will basically be held at the main meeting room (Zoom), but between 15:40-17:00 on Wednesday, October 27 and 13:25-14:45 on Thursday, October 28, Young Scientist Session and Student Session will be held simultaneously using breakout rooms. At those times each individual in the Zoom main room will be able to select the breakout room of their choice, and participate in the session in which their presentation will be given. All participants will be free to move between both breakout rooms.

<Poster Discussion Session>

- The poster discussion session will be held from 15:00 to 17:00 on Thursday, October 28th using the online tool Remo (<u>https://remo.co/</u>). It will be held as an open event that anyone from the eight member institutions can participate in.
- 2. The virtual poster presentation site consists of a two-story floor. The first floor is for Student Session, and the second floor is for Young Scientist Session. However, each participant can move freely between the two floors. There are 16 tables on each floor with a poster number assigned to each one. The individual poster presenter will sit at their poster table during the assigned time to discuss their poster and answer questions. The odd-numbered poster presenters are assigned the first half of the session (15:00-16:00), and the even-numbered poster presenters are assigned the second half of the session (16:00-17:00) as their discussion time.

We would appreciate it if you could participate in the Young Scientist Session and Student Session as much as possible. You can also use the discussion with the poster presenter at the poster discussion session (the virtual poster venue /Remo) to help you decide your vote.
